Subject: Conflict Minerals

Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (the “Conflict Minerals Rule”) imposes certain reporting obligations on public companies whose manufactured products contain conflict minerals that are necessary to the functionality or production of their products. The Conflict Minerals Rule defines “conflict minerals” as: (A) cassiterite, columbite-tantalite (coltan), gold, wolframite, and their derivatives, which are limited by the Act to be tin, tantalum, and tungsten; or (B) any other mineral or its derivatives determined by the Secretary of State to be financing conflict in the Democratic Republic of Congo or any adjoining country.

As a distributor, and not a manufacturer, we do not directly purchase any raw conflict minerals or extended minerals from any source. Indeed, typically our involvement happens much further down the supply chain. As a result, in most instances we are unable to certify as to the country of origin of the conflict minerals contained in our suppliers’ products. Upon request, will use commercially reasonable efforts to work with our suppliers to arrange for them to provide information on the conflict minerals in their products. However, we cannot guarantee that a response will be provided, nor can we vouch for the accuracy of any responses provided.
